Students will complete their National White Card training which is the regulatory authority requirement before entry to a work site. High standards of safe work practices are expected and enforced throughout the course. All students are required to organise and participate in Structured Workplace Learning in industry settings. Entry Requirements	<p>Genuine interest in the Construction Industry and sound literacy and numeracy skills. Pre-course requirement for VFSS funded students is White-Card completion prior to course commencement (\$100 per head). A Term 3 2021 date for White-Card completion TBA</p>
