Course Length	1 Semester (0.5 years) Running in semester 2. In semester 1 students may choose to do SIT20316 Certificate II in Hospitality at Heathfield High School
Course Description	This course offers a range of practical and industry specific skills where the students will gain experience in the service of food and beverage in a range of styles and service environments. Students are provided with the opportunity to apply their skills through various service styles ranging from counter sales through to setting up and service for luncheons and formal dinners.
Pathways	This qualification provides a pathway to work in organisations such as restaurants, hotels, motels, clubs, pubs, cafes and coffee shops. This qualification allows for multiskilling and for specialisation in food and beverage service. It can also lead to further study and qualifications in hospitality management, including Bachelor Degrees.
Entry Requirements	Completion of Certificate II in Hospitality, genuine interest in the hospitality industry and sound literacy and numeracy skills
Other Requirements	Trainees will need to wear closed in black leather shoes, white or black full or ¾ length sleeve business shirt and black dress pants or black business skirt of respectable length (eg: as available from Work Locker in Mt Barker). A display folder, A4 pad, pen and locker padlock are required. Trainees will also need to bring a USB (32GB minimum) for training material storage

The full Certificate III can gain up to 5 Stage 1 credits and up to 55 Stage 2 credits. Full completion of Certificate III in Hospitality can be used in an ATAR calculation.
