This course combines structured workplace training, practical work sessions and theory into a single package designed to give students a work ready qualification.		
Pathways	This certificate reflects the role of entry level employees within the construction industry. Further study in Certificate III in Construction and/or School Based Apprenticeship or Traineeship or a Full Time Apprenticeship in the building construction industry may follow this.
